Eligibility requirements

- Nominations are accepted from all parties; neither the nominee nor the nominator are required to be a WBA member
- It is preferred, but not required, that the woman is currently practicing attorney in the Washington, DC metropolitan area

Process/Timeline

- Submit completed nomination form and supporting documentation prior to the deadline; mailed nominations must be RECEIVED by the deadline
- An Awards Committee will consider all nominations. The committee is comprised of WBA past presidents and prior Woman Lawyer of the Year recipients.
- Acting upon the recommendation of the Awards Committee, the WBA Board will make the final decision.
- Honoree will be notified in advance and invited to attend and provide remarks at the WBA/WBAF Annual Dinner on May 26, 2021.

- Nomination narrative that addresses the nominee's contributions to the legal profession, and/or the advancement of women in the profession.
- Nominee résumé/biography
- Articles by or about the nominee (optional)
- Letters in support of the nomination (optional)
