Small Firm (< 99) Member: \$100/year

- Employed by a firm that employs between 1 and 99 attorneys (refers to firm size, not office size)

In House Counsel Member: \$125/year

Solo Practice Member: \$75/year

- Solo practitioner

Government Member: \$75/year

- Employed by a local or federal government

Non-Profit Member: \$75/year
